Have a conversation with your child's healthcare professional (HCP).

You can help protect your child against invasive pneumococcal disease (IPD). Making the decision to vaccinate your child against invasive pneumococcal disease is an important one. Have a conversation with your child's healthcare professional about vaccinating your child. Knowing what questions to ask can help you make the most of your visit.

The following questions can help you get a conversation started. The spaces below each question will give you an opportunity to take notes and to write down any questions of your own.

Questions for your child's healthcare professional:
